BASIC FUNCTION OF POSITION:

The incumbent is the local economics expert and principal advisor to the Economic Growth Office (EG), the Economic Growth Team USAID/Indonesia particularly in the areas related to Mission activities and to Indonesian national, regional and international economic development; trade and investment, macro-microeconomics, finance and debt policy; statistics; population, labor and poverty trends and gender issues; with special attention to the “real economy” (private sector); including food policy and analysis for such sectors as telecommunications, manufacturing and energy.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

At a minimum, applicant must have the following:

1. Master’s degree in Economics, Agricultural Economic, or related fields required with a PhD desirable.



2. Minimum ten years of progressively responsible experience in development economics works, including research analysis and policy briefing preferably including in the area of agriculture development and at least five years experience in managing development projects in large donor agencies or equivalent private sector work.
3. English and Indonesian fluency at Level IV (written and oral) is required.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

In addition to the above criteria relating to education, experience and language proficiency, the following criteria will also be used to evaluate applicants:

1. Thorough knowledge of the concepts, principles, techniques, and practices of sound development assistance.
2. Knowledge of Government of Indonesia (GOI) policies in the areas of macro and micro-economic, finance and financial institutions, commercial, service industries, trade and investment, labor issues, and rural bank institutions and related regulations and procedures.
